

Northern Frontier Father and Son Fishing Trip

It will be a pleasure to have you at Northern Frontier this Summer. We are looking forward to your arrival and have been making plans for what we hope is going to be a great time for you.

The Fishing Trip is ideal for the outdoorsman as your main activities are fishing and camping. You will develop your skills in all these areas including outdoor cooking. You will hike with a pack (three miles) to remote locations on the various wilderness lakes and possibly the Hudson River Gorge on Northern Frontier's property and bordering NY State lands. It's a good idea to do some walking before you come!

If you plan to fish during the trip, a NY State fishing license is required for every one 16 years and older. Cost for a NY State resident is \$12.00 for a 7-day permit or \$25.00 for the season, \$5 for seniors (70+). Non-resident costs are \$28.00 for a 7-day permit or \$50.00 for a full season. **Please purchase it before your arrival at camp.**

The kinds of fish you might be catching, depending on location, are small mouth bass, large mouth bass, northern pike, trout, yellow perch, sunfish, and rock bass.

A daily Bible exploration and informal sharing each evening around the campfire are highlights of the day as you discover how the Bible speaks to you as fathers and sons.

Plan your arrival at Northern Frontier after 11:00 AM and before 12:30 PM. Come immediately to the Administration Building to register. The trip concludes after breakfast on the final day.

Fathers and their sons who come **only** for the Father/Son Program **do not need** a physician's examination. **However, we do require both of you to complete and sign the "Camper Health History Form 1" prior to coming to camp. Form 2 is not required. The NY State Health Department forbids us to admit your son without a complete up-to-date immunization record.** Please give the information requested on your family medical/hospital insurance. If needed, your policy will be used first since the camp provides only limited, non-duplicative coverage.

WHAT TO BRING

Optional: Any of your own camping gear; camera. If you'd like to submit your pictures for possible inclusion in Northern Frontier's brochure or newsletters, stop in at the Camp Office after the trip.

Northern Frontier will provide: packs, tents, food, cooking equipment and utensils, water filter/purifier

If you should have to cancel, please notify us as soon as possible, so another father/son pair can have the opportunity to participate in this enjoyable adventure.

**PO Box 295, Route 28
North River, NY 12856

- New York State Thruway to exit 24
- Route 87 north (Northway) to exit 23 (Warrensburg)
- At end of ramp go left (west) 0.2 miles to light at junction of Route 9
- Go right onto Route 9 following it north for 4.1 miles to Route 28, which goes off to the left
- Follow Route 28 approximately 21 miles to the hamlet of North River, NY
- After passing through North River, you will cross a railroad track and start up a long hill. 3.6 miles from that railroad track is the Northern Frontier sign and road on your right {Landmark: A large rocking chair (furniture maker's display) is on the right side of Route 28 seven-tenths-of-a-mile (0.7 miles) before the camp driveway.}
